Ketchikan Open House about Corps Regulatory Program set for August 16, 2011

The public is invited to an informational meeting in Ketchikan on Tuesday, August 16, 2011, where representatives of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Regulatory Division will discuss their program and answer questions. Topics will include work and activities that require a permit, types of permits, how to apply for permits including required application information, wetland delineations, laws and regulations, and the value of early coordination and planning.

This 2-hour session will be particularly meaningful for landowners, contractors, businesses, and others who wish to learn about the Corps regulatory responsibilities and services. The meeting will include an agency presentation, the opportunity for questions and answers, and time for one-on-one dialogue.
