SECURITY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICE1. Security and Law Enforcement.

a. Advises the Commanding General and Division Engineer concerning law enforcement issues and provides supervision over Provost Marshal activities within the Pacific Ocean Division (POD).

b. Exercises oversight of the Information Assurance Program.

c. Ensures that security managers are designated at the district level.

d. Maintains liaison with security manager personnel at higher echelons and appropriate Army, Navy, and Air Force agencies as required.

e. Coordinates all matters concerning the release of engineer information to foreign nationals. Coordinates visitor control matters of foreign nationals.

f. Reviews existing directives and establishes and supervises local policies and procedures for the receipt, storage, and transmission of classified information.

g. Administers the industrial and personnel security programs.

h. Coordinates with local military and civilian law enforcement agencies concerning support for emergencies or disturbances on or near U.S. Army Corps of Engineer construction sites or facilities.

i. Provides assistance in the development of contingency operations and plans.

j. Completes reports as required.

2. Acting Engineer Inspector General.

a. Acts as an impartial and confidential advisor to the Commanding General and Division Engineer for the purpose of receiving and handling complaints and requests for assistance.

b. Performs functions inherent in the duties of the Acting Inspector General by ensuring that each employee has convenient access to the Acting Inspector General, which requires, as a minimum, an annual visit to the Districts/outlying resident offices.
