CONSTRUCTION SITE VISITS BY DESIGN PERSONNEL

1. PURPOSE. This regulation provides guidance and instructions for field visits by review and design personnel of projects under construction.
2. APPLICABILITY. This PODR applies to all design organizations of the Pacific Ocean Division.
3. REFERENCES.
 - a. ER 10-1-3, Organization and Functions - Divisions and Districts
 - b. ER 1110-1-8, Required Visits to Construction Sites by Design Personnel
4. POLICY. Appendix XIII, ER 10-1-3 and ER 1110-1-8 require that engineering divisions perform regularly scheduled site visits of projects under construction. Primary purposes are to:
 - a. Determine whether field conditions are as they were expected to be during design.
 - b. Assist field personnel in interpreting the plans and specifications.
 - c. Observe firsthand problems which may not have been fully evaluated in the original design.
 - d. Prevent repetitive deficiencies by adding observed deficiencies on POD Design Check List.
5. OBJECTIVE. To improve design by establishment of procedures for construction site visits.
6. POLICY AND ACTION.
 - a. Field visits by review and design personnel are not to be considered as merely "desirable," but as mandatory and an essential phase of the design process. These are in addition to any visits which may be requested by Construction Division.

b. Prior to and during field visits by design personnel, coordination with Construction Division and project engineers will be accomplished to insure that maximum benefits are realized.
